

# WATER TANK SANITIZING INSTRUCTIONS

The water tank is designed to hold 72 gallons of potable water. To ensure a sanitary tank and to protect against contaminated water, the tank must be sanitized after every use and before storage or transportation.

Follow the steps below to sanitize the water tank:

1. Disconnect the water supply tube from the FCB unit.
2. Open the water fill port and pour 36 ounces\* of household chlorine bleach into the tank.
3. Fill the tank to overflowing with potable water.
4. Allow the tank to rest in the full condition for 30 minutes.
5. Completely drain the water/bleach solution from the tank.
6. Close the drain valve.

The water system is now ready for shipment or storage.

**Note: When putting the system back into service, flush approximately 5 gallons of water through the tank before filling.**

\* 36 oz of bleach in 72 gallons of water will produce a 200 PPM solution of chlorine. Do not exceed this amount.
