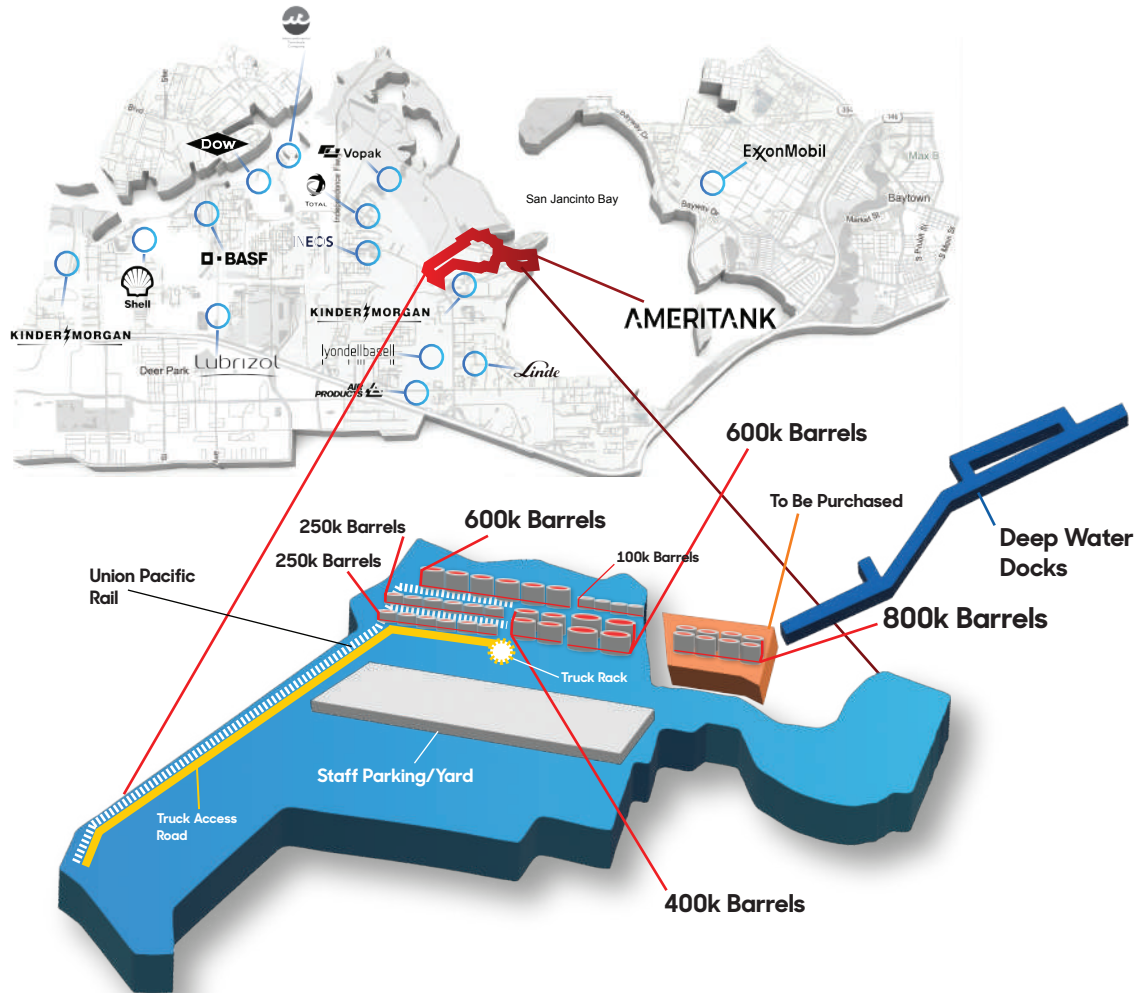


La Porte Marine Terminal

Terminal Specs

- 30 acres dedicated upland with deep water dock
- API-650 carbon steel and stainless steel storage tanks
- Concrete ring-wall foundations with secondary containment
- Lined earthen berms for spill prevention
- Truck and rail loading racks
- Pump stations, pigging facilities, and manifold systems
- 34-month phased development timeline (6 phases)

Commodities Handled

- Refined Petroleum Products, Crude Oil, Condensate
- Blendstocks, Distillates, Jet Fuels
- Segregated Chemicals, Ethanol, NGLs

Access

- Marine: Deep water dock on Houston Ship Channel
- Dedicated bulkhead/pier for liquid transfer operations
- Highway: 2.4 miles from Highway 225/Beltway 8
- Rail: Union Pacific rail spur on-site
- Pipeline: 25+ pipeline crossings include Kinder Morgan (natural gas), Occidental (natural gas), Houston Pipeline Co. (natural gas), Enterprise/TEPPCO (nitrogen, isobutane, ethane, gasoline/jet fuel/diesel), Equistar (isobutane, butane/butylene, natural gasoline, propylene, ethylene, gasoline/jet fuel/diesel), Koch (propylene, ethylene), Shell (anhydrous HCl, ethylene), Williams Olefins (HCl), Air Products (carbon monoxide, hydrogen), and Air Liquide (hydrogen)
