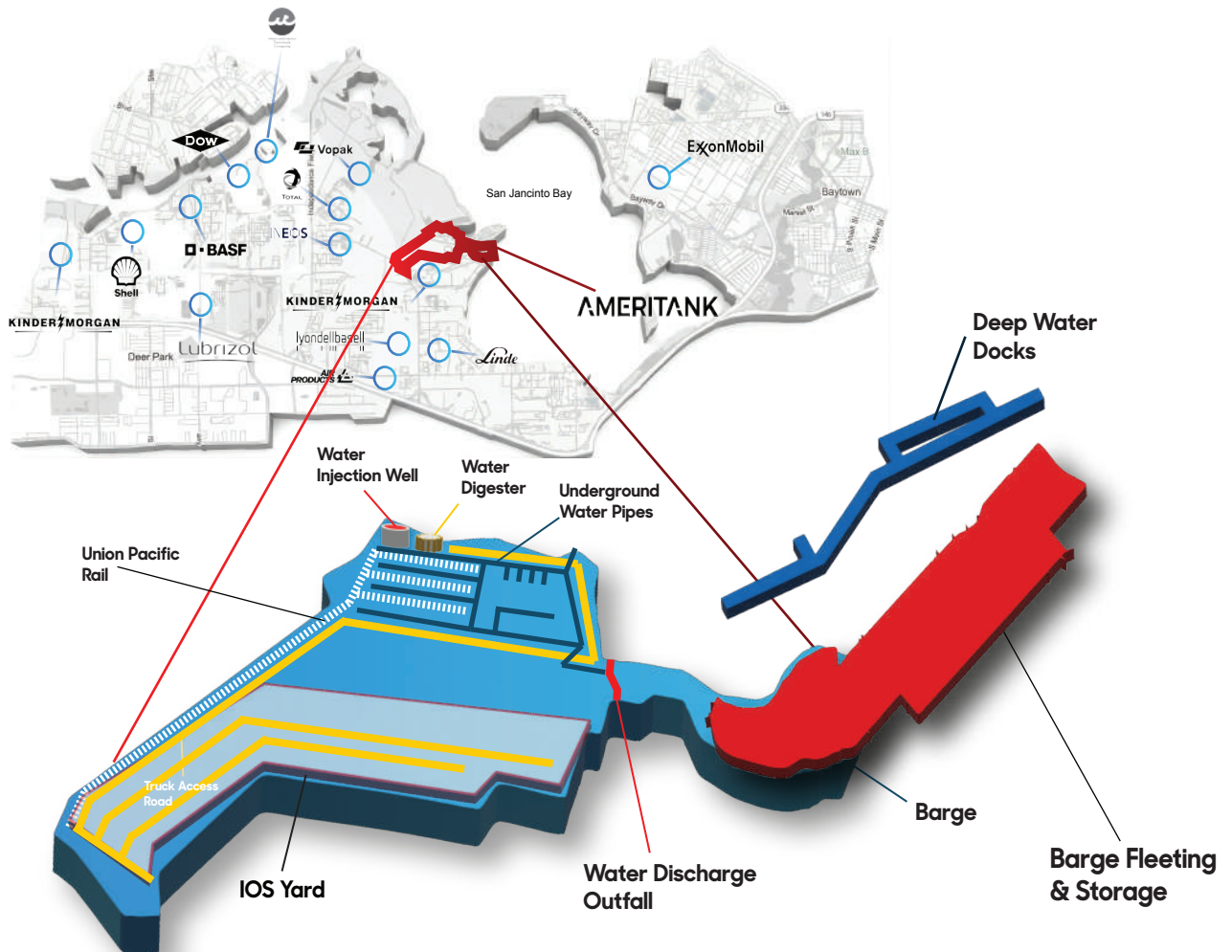


La Porte Barge Fleeting & Storage

Facility Specifications

- 66-barge fleeting capacity
- 150-foot-wide access channel
- Channel depth maintained at -4.0' NAVD88
- 16 mooring dolphins for secure fleeting
- Shallow-draft tugboat and pushboat access
- Located at Mile Marker 308 on Houston Ship Channel

Vessel Specifications

- River Barges: 300' LOA × 54' Beam, 2.5'-3.5' draft
- Chemical Barges: 185' LOA × 35' Beam, 2.5'-3.0' draft
- Optimized for light-loaded and empty barge storage
- 150-foot channel width for safe maneuvering
