Higher costs and thousands of jobs lost



1 in 3 adult New Yorkers receive a delivery on an average day – that’s 2.5 million daily packages.

63% of voters say it’s “very important” for local officials to keep prices down for online shopping.

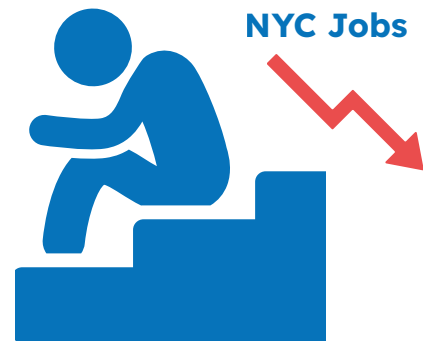

Intro 518 would materially **increase the average cost of delivery for NYC households** by \$408 to \$664 each year.

3,000 to 10,000+ NYers would lose their jobs when facilities delivering to NYC move to New Jersey. These lost jobs belong disproportionately to New Yorkers with no college degree (82%) and who are non-White (84%).

Vehicle Miles



Intro 518 would **add 16 million “vehicle miles” traveled** annually to NYC streets, **increasing congestion** as larger vehicles would travel longer distance to reach consumers, primarily in South Bronx, Central Queens, and Central Brooklyn.
