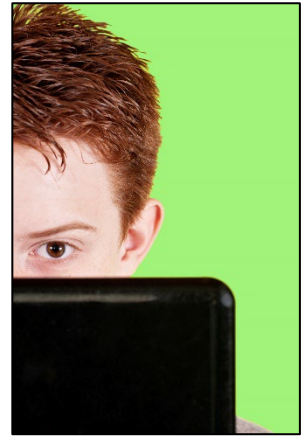




Rules of Behaviour

Please remember to:

- 🍑 Be polite and respectful to your teacher and other students.
- 🍑 Listen to others and allow everyone the opportunity to contribute.
- 🍑 Follow your teacher's instructions and take part in your learning as much as you can.
- 🍑 Use the chat and other classroom tools appropriately.
- 🍑 Do not use language or behaviour that is unkind, threatening, discriminatory or offensive.
- 🍑 Respect other people's privacy.
- 🍑 Keep your classroom links and login details private and do not share them with anyone else.
- 🍑 Tell your teacher or another trusted adult if anything happens online that makes you feel worried, uncomfortable or unsafe.

What happens if the rules are not followed?

Your teacher will usually talk to you first and help you understand what needs to change.

If inappropriate behaviour continues, your teacher may remove you from the online classroom or report the concern to Apricot.

Where necessary, Apricot may also speak to your parent/carer and/or the school or local authority responsible for your placement.

Any action taken will be fair and proportionate and will take account of your individual needs and circumstances.

Serious behaviour or anything that raises a safeguarding concern will be dealt with under Apricot's safeguarding procedures.

Remember: these rules are here to help everyone feel safe, respected and able to learn.
