LEAD



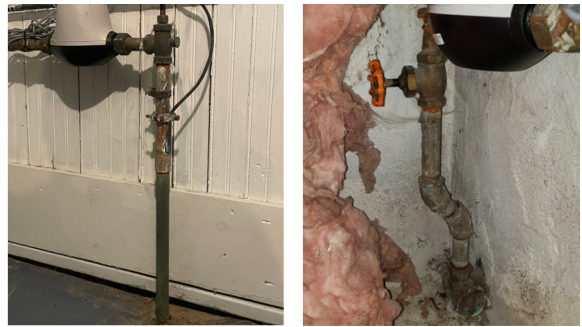
Outer Appearance: Dull gray, bendable;
Often curves between wall/floor and valve

Threads at Connection: No

Scratch Test (Coin or Key): Shiny Silver

Magnet Test: Does not stick

GALVANIZED IRON



Outer Appearance: Dark gray or black;
Straight rigid pipe

Threads at Connection: Yes

Scratch Test (Coin or Key): Dull silver

Magnet Test: Magnet WILL stick

COPPER



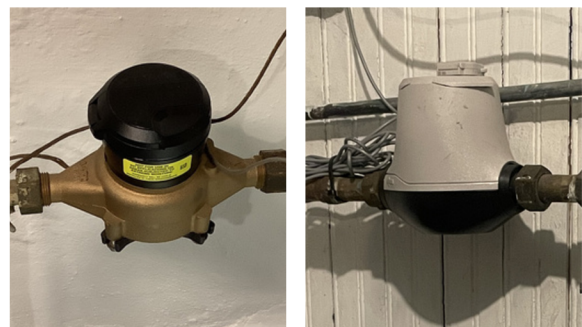
Outer Appearance: Dull Brown; Can have
green corrosion spots

Threads at Connection: No

Scratch Test (Coin or Key): Copper, like penny

Magnet Test: Does not stick

METER HORN



If you only see a meter horn (shown above) where your water line enters your home, your line is below ground and can't be self-verified with a photo. An EquiFlow specialist will need to inspect it in person - please contact us today if you haven't already.
