



Compliance with the European Union's (EU's) WEEE Directive

In August of 2005, the European Union (EU) implemented the EU WEEE (Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment) Directive 2002/96/EC and later the EU's WEEE Recast Directive 2012/19/EU. The Directive requires producers of electronic equipment to manage and finance the collection, reuse, recycling and to appropriately treat WEEE the producer places on the EU market after August 13, 2005. The goals are to minimize the volume of WEEE disposal and encourage the re-use and recycling of products at the end of their useful life.
