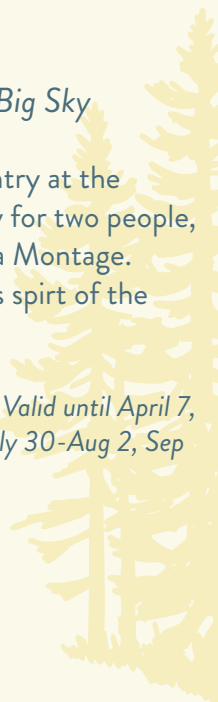


Montage Big Sky Getaway
