In January, a total US visa ban was put on Ethiopia and many other countries. Even though it is deeply frustrating, we also feel so much inexplicable peace to trust God and serve right where we are at the moment.

Bereket is learning some new skills and has a passion for carpentry this season. He has built all the furniture in our new apartment, and is already using his gifts to serve church members. He is so talented and creative, and we hope he can use this skill for future ministry as well. Abby is almost halfway through her online school for social work, and is also excited to see how God will use this in the future.
