## Full Bio

Paul H. Tice spent 40 years working on Wall Street at some of the industry’s most recognizable firms, including J.P. Morgan, Lehman Brothers, Deutsche Bank/Bankers Trust, and BlackRock. For most of his finance career, he specialized in the energy sector—both as a top-ranked sell-side research analyst and a buy-side investment manager—which also made him an expert in climate policy and environmental regulation and its financial offshoot, the ESG and sustainable investment movement. Tice is the author of “The Race to Zero: How ESG Investing Will Crater the Global Financial System (Encounter Books, 2024).”

Since 2017, Tice has been an adjunct professor of finance at New York University’s Stern School of Business, where he has taught about the energy, infrastructure, and project finance markets. He joined the National Center for Energy Analytics as a senior fellow and a member of its Board of Advisors in March 2024.
