Our Commitment to Privacy

VerdictHub (“VerdictHub,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) is committed to protecting the privacy and confidentiality of the information entrusted to us.

VerdictHub provides AI-assisted jury research and litigation analysis services to attorneys and law firms. Attorneys submit case materials directly to our team, and we use proprietary tools internally to generate analytical reports and work product that is delivered back to the attorney.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, protect, and share information provided to us in connection with our services or through our website.

By using our website or engaging our services, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Summary of Key Privacy Principles

- **We do not sell personal data.**
- We use client-submitted materials solely to provide our litigation analysis services.
- We treat attorney-submitted materials as confidential.
- We limit access to information to authorized personnel only.
- We implement technical and organizational safeguards to protect data.
- You may request access to, correction of, or deletion of personal information we maintain (subject to legal and contractual obligations).

1. Who We Are

VerdictHub is a litigation support service provider offering AI-assisted jury research and case analysis to attorneys and law firms.

VerdictHub acts as:

- A **service provider** to attorneys and law firms; and
- A **data controller** for information collected directly through our website.

2. Information We Collect

Because VerdictHub operates as a managed service (not a public self-service platform), we collect information in the following ways:

A. Information Submitted by Attorneys

Attorneys and law firms may provide:

- Case summaries
- Pleadings and court filings
- Evidence summaries
- Deposition excerpts
- Jury instructions
- Verdict forms
- Damages models
- Factual narratives
- Contact information for case-related personnel

These materials may contain:

- Personal information
- Sensitive information
- Litigation-related data
- Information subject to attorney-client privilege or work-product protections

We process this information solely to provide our services.

B. Contact and Business Information

We may collect:

- Name
- Law firm name

- Email address
- Phone number
- Billing information
- Communications with our team

This information is collected when:

- You contact us
 - You request information
 - You engage our services

C. Website Usage Information

When you visit verdicthub.ai, we may automatically collect:

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device type
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages

This information is collected via cookies and analytics tools and is used to improve our website.

3. How We Use Information

We use information to:

- Provide jury research and analytical services
- Generate reports and litigation insights
- Communicate with attorneys and law firms
- Process billing and payments
- Improve our services and website

- Maintain security and prevent misuse
- Comply with legal obligations

We do **not** use client-submitted materials for advertising or marketing purposes.

4. Confidentiality of Case Materials

VerdictHub understands that litigation materials may be highly sensitive.

Accordingly:

- Case materials are used solely for the purpose of generating the requested work product.
- Access is restricted to authorized team members who require access to perform services.
- We do not disclose case materials to third parties except service providers bound by confidentiality obligations.
- We do not publish or publicly reference client case materials without express permission.

VerdictHub does not provide legal advice and does not enter into an attorney-client relationship with represented parties.

5. How We Share Information

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information.

We may share information only in the following limited circumstances:

Service Providers

We may use trusted vendors for:

- Secure cloud hosting
- Email services
- Document processing
- Data storage

- Payment processing

All service providers are contractually required to:

- Maintain confidentiality
- Implement appropriate security measures
- Use data only to provide services to VerdictHub

Legal Requirements

We may disclose information if required by law, subpoena, court order, or other legal process.

6. Data Retention

We retain information:

- For as long as necessary to provide services
- To maintain business records
- To comply with legal, regulatory, or contractual obligations

Attorneys may request deletion of case materials after completion of services, subject to legal retention requirements.

7. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect information against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction.

Security measures include:

- Encrypted data transmission (where applicable)
- Secure cloud infrastructure
- Access controls and role-based permissions
- Employee confidentiality agreements
- Limited internal access to sensitive materials

However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is 100% secure.

10. Children’s Privacy

VerdictHub’s services are intended for attorneys and law firms. Our website and services are not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

11. Your Privacy Rights
