<p>Write a news article on the Pompeii eruption!</p> 	<p>Learn at least 5 facts about a Gladiator. Make a fact file about what their life was like.</p>	<p>Make your own Roman mosaic using cut paper, pasta shapes, seeds etc. Keep the design simple</p>
<p>Research a famous scientist who created an important electrical invention and present your findings.</p>	<p>Create a fact file or e-presentation on either Severus, Boudica or C.Ceasar</p> 	<p>Make some Roman Honey Cakes or any other Roman food. Write the recipe/take a photo/bring the food into school.</p> 
<p>Design a roman chariot or armour for a soldier.</p> 	<p>Design or create your own amphitheatre.</p> 	<p>Choose a Roman invention. Prepare a short presentation which could be a talk or a PowerPoint (emailed or on a memory stick) to share with the class.</p>
<p>Create a soundscape. Sit somewhere, close your eyes and listen. Then record everything you can hear, through drawings or writing.</p>	<p>Stretch cling film tightly over the top of a plastic bowl and secure it with a rubber band. Sprinkle a few grains of rice or salt on top. Hum or shout loudly near the bowl to see how the sound vibrations make the rice jump</p>	<p>Thread a piece of string through the bottom of two paper cups and tie knots so the string doesn't pull through. Pull the string taut between you and a friend. Speak into a cup while your friend places the cup against their ear to learn about how sound travels through solids</p>
