

Baptisms and Marriages at Haworth Church

Baptism is a core sign and symbol of Christian faith. With adults or older children it can show a decision to follow Jesus, or a recommitment to faith. It is a celebration of God's love, and our response to Jesus's call to follow Him as we commit ourselves to live Jesus's way - shining for Him in the world.



For those exploring baptism (for themselves or their child/children) we normally recommend that you come along to a few services to give you a chance to connect with people and place here.

If you would like to celebrate and give thanks for the birth of your child but don't want to make a Christian commitment with/for them at this stage then you might like to consider Thanksgiving, which includes prayers of blessing for your child and family and would normally be done as part of one of our regular services.

Weddings are a wonderful celebration of love and commitment. Our three church buildings are all available for weddings, marriage blessings, or renewal of vows ceremonies. An important part of the Church of England legal framework for weddings is to have a 'qualifying connection', which you can read about at:
