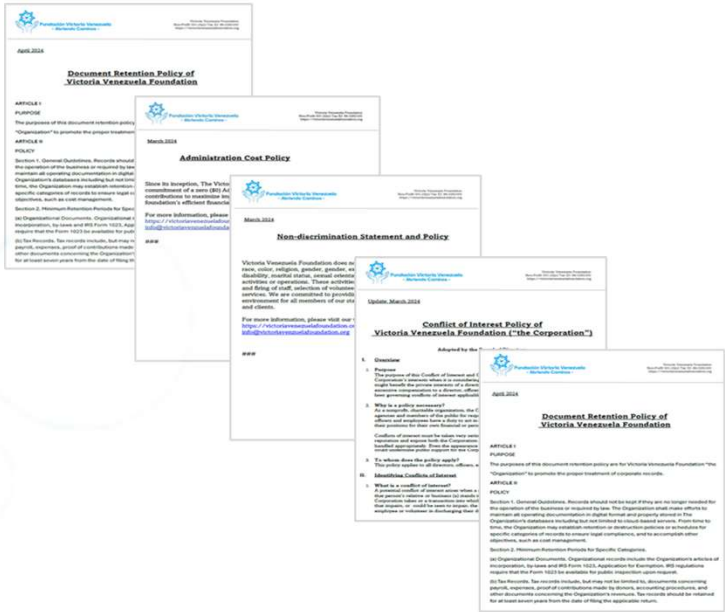

Major annual achievements included the **(Platinum Rating)** by GuideStar as an **exemplary organization**.

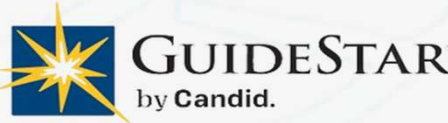
