<b>Reception</b>	<p>In Reception children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talk about members of their own family and community</li> <li>• Name and describe people who are familiar to them</li> <li>• Comment on images of familiar situations in the past</li> <li>• Compare and contrast characters from stories including those from the past</li> </ul> <p>ELG: Talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society; Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class; Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling;</p>
