Who is Eligible?

- California resident, living anywhere in the state
- 18 years of age or older
- Currently have little or no health insurance
- Income currently at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Have an abnormal DRE or elevated PSA
- Told by a doctor that you have prostate cancer
