AB 1305 California Voluntary Carbon Market Disclosures Act Information (Section 44475.2)

This disclosure is provided pursuant to California Assembly Bill No. 1305 (AB 1305), which added Division 25, Part 10 (Voluntary Carbon Market Disclosures) to the California Health and Safety Code. AB 1305 requires certain disclosures from entities that make emissions-related claims or market voluntary carbon offsets (VCOs).

RIVIX does not use, purchase, or market voluntary carbon offsets from any project located in California.

RIVIX supplies apparel, uniforms, and sourcing programs to companies across Canada and the United States. Our services include production management, fabric sourcing, logistics coordination, and compliance oversight. RIVIX conducts its operations with a commitment to transparency, accuracy, and regulatory compliance.

VOLUNTARY CARBON OFFSET DISCLOSURE: EMISSIONS CLAIMS

As of January 2026:

- RIVIX has not purchased any carbon offsets or voluntary carbon offsets (VCOs).
- RIVIX has not participated in any carbon offset or credit programs, within or outside the State of California.
- RIVIX has not made public statements regarding net-zero targets, greenhouse gas (GHG) reductions, or emissions performance that rely on carbon offsets.
- RIVIX does not market its apparel, sourcing, or production programs as carbon neutral or emissions offset.
