Purpose

RIVIX confirms that all apparel and related products supplied under our programs are manufactured and delivered in accordance with applicable Canadian regulations, recognized international standards, and client specific technical requirements.

We do not release product into production or shipment without documented confirmation that required standards are met.

Scope

This declaration applies to:

- Workwear and industrial garments
- High visibility and safety apparel
- Uniform programs
- Protective outerwear
- Promotional and branded apparel
- Private label product programs

Regulatory Compliance

RIVIX ensures that supplied products comply with all relevant legislation and regulatory frameworks applicable to the intended market of distribution, including where required:

- Canadian flammability and textile labeling regulations
- Consumer product safety requirements
- CSA visibility and safety garment requirements where specified
- Applicable EN or ANSI standards where contractually required
- Import and customs documentation standards

Where garments are required to meet specific protection ratings such as flame resistance, high visibility classification, or performance specifications, production is aligned to the certified material and construction standards referenced in the client's technical documents.

Material and Construction Controls

All production programs are governed by documented technical specifications approved prior to bulk manufacturing.

This includes:

- Fabric composition and performance confirmation
- Trim and component verification
- Branding and labeling accuracy
- Size grading and pattern consistency
- Packaging and labeling compliance

No substitutions are made without written client approval.

Testing and Inspection

RIVIX maintains a structured quality control process that includes:

- Pre production sample approval
- In line quality inspections
- Final random inspection prior to shipment
- Measurement verification against approved spec sheets
- Visual and construction review of stitching, labeling, and finishing

Where required by contract, third party laboratory testing and inspection reports can be arranged and provided.

Documentation and Traceability

Upon request, RIVIX can provide:

- Certificates of conformity
- Material test reports
- Inspection summaries
- Technical specification sheets
- Import documentation and supporting compliance records

All documentation is retained in accordance with project and client requirements.
