2026 TOURNAMENT OPTIONS

Option 1 - \$70

- Modified Shotguns - 50 players or less
- Modified shotguns will be scheduled 9am or sooner

Option2 - \$75

- Between 51 and 140 players
- This is a shotgun tournament
- Must be played at either 8 am or 1:30 pm
- Minimum commitment of \$30 in food and beverage

The rented space is allocated to a set time to accommodate other events.

Tournaments with fewer than 80 golfers may be subject to member participation.

ALL TOURNAMENT OPTIONS INCLUDE:

- 18 holes of golf and shared power cart
- Set up of registration area, and assistance with registration
- Placement and collection of sponsor signs on the golf course
- On course contest markers - Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin etc...
- Greeting of guests and bag drop
- Microphone, podium, and sound equipment if required for greeting and announcements

HOW TO MAXIMIZE CHARITY CONTRIBUTIONS

Golf outings offer a unique and flexible approach to fundraising, providing more than just a fun day on the greens. They are an effective way to maximize charity contributions.

Putting Contest

All of our putting contest with your tournament must be held prior to your event. All players will putt at the same time to a hole that is placed in the middle of the green.



Selling Mulligan

A mulligan, most simply put, is a “do-over.” Hit a bad shot? Take a mulligan and replay that stroke. An easy and inexpensive way to make money for your charity golf tournament.

Pro for Hire - \$200 per day

The golf course holding the event will provide you with a golf pro, who will be stationed at the longest and most difficult hole on the course. They will be there for the length of the day. This pro should be one who has a particular skill for hitting very long drives. Golfers will have the option to pay the pro to make the shot.

Closest to the Pin

This event is hosted on a par 3, a marker is placed at the ball that is hit closest to the pin. The marker can be moved with each group as the closest to the hole can change with each group.

Longest Drive

This event is very similar to “Closest to the Pin” in the way it is run. A prize is awarded for the longest drive off the tee to the fairway. This is generally played on a par five hole. Markers are provided by the club.

Closest to the Object


An object or rope can be placed in the fairway and the player's ball, throughout the day, who is closest to the object or line is the winner.

“Super Ticket”

This ticket includes; Putting Contest, Mulligans, Longest Drive and Closest to the Pin. Players are to purchase this upon arrival in order to be included in all of the days competitions. This ticket usually generates a great profit for your organization, and is a great way to mix things up on the course.

Leaderboard Scoring

Ability to have live leaderboard scoring after each hole. Follow the action in the clubhouse, on the patio, or on your mobile with live leaderboards, photos and more.

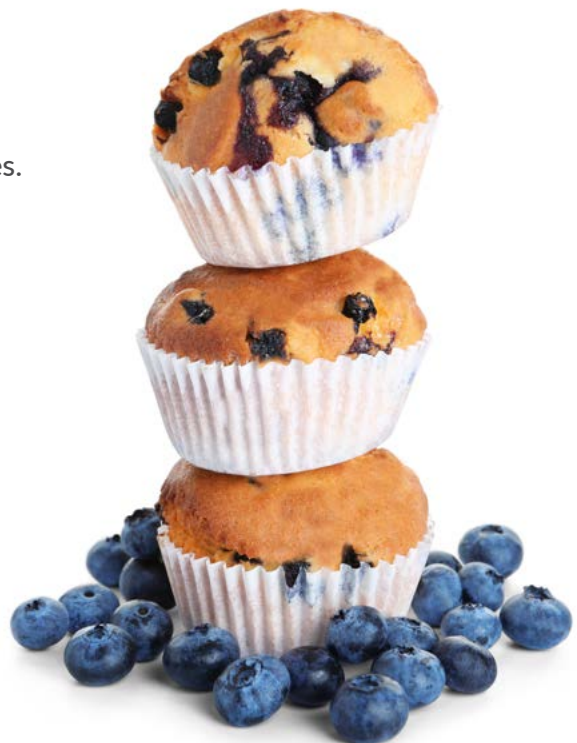

TOURNAMENT CHECKLIST

Prepare for a seamless tournament experience with this helpful checklist.

150-365 Days Prior

- Secure date for tournament.
- Determine name and size of tournament.
- Preliminary budget - use our planning tools.
- Develop project plan.
- Solicit potential sponsors.
- Submit Confirmation & sign Tournament Agreement.

150-365 Days Prior

- Update budget.
- Update project plan & volunteers.
- Discuss tournament format and meals.
- Set up Hole-in-One contests and contracts.
- Follow-up with potential sponsors.
- Select menu.
- Banquet set up (# of guests, AV equip., prize table etc.)
- Bar Requirements.

30-60 Days Prior

- Order required signage.
- Send details, rules, and agenda to participants.
- Secure hole in one insurance.
- Coordinate volunteers.
- Special order registration gift or prizes from the pro shop.
- Send out directions to course, dress code. including spike, and alcohol policy.

14-30 Days Prior

- Adjust participant numbers if required.
- Prepare registration list.
- Identify tournament contests and prizes.
- Finalize agenda for tournament day.
- Finalize rules for tournament day.
- Secure photographer.
- Finalize sponsor support.
- Confirm number of club rentals required.
- Sight visit and tour of Rochester Place .

12 Days Prior

- Confirm number of golfers and types of meals needed.
- Confirm on course contests with course.
- Confirm registration set up with the course.
- Confirm deliveries to the course.
- Confirm Volunteers as well as duties and responsibilities.
- Revise pairings.
- Final meal count submitted. Refers to the minimum number of meals to be charged day of event.
- Email pairings for tournament play minimum 5 days in advance.

48-Hours Prior

- Finalize details with course management
- Deliver all course signs and materials.

Day of Event

- Arrive early to coordinate set up with course.
- Set up registration and prize tables.
- Coordinate volunteers.
- Decorate banquet room.
- Prizes delivered ahead will be placed in a designated staging area, we recommend you assign a team to assist in setup of prizes.

Post Tournament

- Reconcile invoices and final payment not more than 5 days after event.
- Finalize budget and profit/loss statement.
- Send thank-you replies to participants.
- Update your website with tournament results.
- Rebook tournament for following year.
