What is this product?

TYPE

The product is a sub-fund of BCI AM SICAV, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

TERM

The Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However the Board of Directors may decide to close this product under certain circumstances.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Fund is to obtain a superior return, in the medium and long term, over the MSCI ACWI Index (the MSCI ACWI Index) through investments in UCITS and/or other UCI having an exposure to stocks or equity related securities of issuers domiciled all over the world, in both developed and emerging markets.

The Fund will be actively managed. The MSCI ACWI Index is mentioned only for information purposes in order to give an indication on the Fund's investment universe with respect to countries, regions, sectors and types of issuers. The Fund does not intend to track, nor to replicate the return of the MSCI ACWI Index and the MSCI ACWI Index will not be used for the purpose of determining or restricting the Fund's asset allocation. For the avoidance of doubt, the Fund may invest into securities that are not comprised in the MSCI ACWI Index.

The Fund will invest mainly in UCITS and/or other UCIs domiciled in the EEA having an exposure to equity and equity linked securities (such as funds, ETFs, depositary receipt, convertibles securities and equity linked notes) of issuers domiciled all over the world, in both developed (around 80% of the Fund's NAV, depending on the prevailing market conditions) and emerging markets (around 20% of the Sub-Fund's NAV, depending on the prevailing market conditions). Under normal market conditions, indirect exposure to equity and equity linked securities via UCITS and/or other UCIs will represent at least 70% of the Fund's assets.

Investments in UCITS and/or other UCI having an exposure to contingent convertible bonds (CoCos) and/or Defaulted and/or Distressed Debt Securities, are not contemplated while not excluded and if, will not exceed each more than 10% of the Fund's NAV level and not material at level of the target UCITS and/or other UCI.

On an ancillary basis, the Fund may invest indirectly, via UCITS and/or other UCIs in any other type of Eligible Investments, including but not limited to debt securities, cash and cash equivalents (i.e. cash deposits and money market instruments).

The Fund will not use SFT and financial derivative instruments (including TRS).

Please refer to the Prospectus for more information about the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation ("SFDR") classification of the Fund.

The recommended holding period of this product is determined to allow sufficient time for this product to reach its objectives and avoiding short term market fluctuations.

The return of the product is determined using the net asset value calculated by the Central administration.

This return depends mainly on the market value fluctuations of the underlying investments.

In principle, capital gains and other income of the Fund will be re-invested and no dividend will generally be payable to shareholders.

INTENDED RETAIL INVESTOR

The product is suitable for investors having an advisory account serviced by any of the Sub-fund's Distributors. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 3 years.

Redemptions are possible every Business Day (a day on which banks are generally open for business in Luxembourg). All redemption requests must be received in good order by the Registrar and Transfer Agent prior to 3 p.m (Central European time) on the relevant Valuation Day (each Business Day). Redemption proceeds shall be paid in the relevant reference currency usually within four (4) Business Days following the relevant Valuation Day.

Investors may convert shares in the Fund for shares in other sub-funds. Further information and provisions are in the Prospectus.

This key information document describes the named Sub-Fund; however, the prospectus and the periodic reports are prepared for all the sub-funds of the Fund.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 3 years.

The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

What happens if FundSight S.A. is unable to pay out?

FundSight S.A. is not making any payment to you in relation to this Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from FundSight S.A.

The Fund's assets are held with UBS Europe SE, Luxembourg Branch and are segregated from the assets of other sub-funds of the Company. The assets of the Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other sub-funds of the Company.

What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommended holding period: 3 years.

The recommended holding period was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.
