PRACTICE MODERATION WHEN CONSUMING ALCOHOL. AVOID USING DRUG USE.

- EPHESIANS 5:18 NIV– “Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit,”
- GALATIANS 5:19-21 NLT– “When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.”

STAY ON TASK.

- MATTHEW 5:37 CEB– “Let your yes mean yes, and your *no* mean no. Anything more than this comes from the evil one.”

DRESS MODESTLY & APPROPRIATELY.

- 1 PETER 1:15-16 CEB– “you must be holy in every aspect of your lives, just as the one who called you is holy. It is written, *“You will be holy, because I am holy.”*”
- **Shorts at fingertip length**
- **No inappropriate graphic tees**
- **Shirts must cover your entire torso (no skin showing) - even when hands lifted**
- **No cut off tees**
- **Dresses must be fingertip length or lower**
- **No spaghetti straps**

PRACTICE A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW OF SEXUALITY.

- 1 CORINTHIANS 6:9-10 CEB– “Don’t you know that people who are unjust won’t inherit God’s kingdom? Don’t be deceived. Those who are sexually immoral, those who worship false gods, adulterers, both participants in same-sex intercourse, thieves, the greedy, drunks, abusive people, and swindlers won’t inherit God’s kingdom.”
- 1 CORINTHIANS 6:18 CEB– “Avoid sexual immorality! Every sin that a person can do is committed outside the body, except those who engage in sexual immorality commit sin against their own bodies.”
- **Avoid using pornography**
- **Commit to sex only within marriage**
- **Choose not to cohabit outside of marriage**
- **Avoid being active in or promoting a homosexual lifestyle**
- **Engage in appropriate adult to student relationships**

SERVE ONE ATTEND ONE.

- We ask that all of our volunteers in Bayside YTH are prioritizing their spiritual growth by attending a service when they serve. This helps keep everyone in unity as a Church body in regards to what the leadership of the Church is sharing and being led to communicate.
