

## On Mission, Video Script 1

**Welcome back!**

As you have already learned:

A leader at Bayside is a fully devoted follower of Christ who lives a life that seeks to **put God first, is others focused and lives on mission.**

**So, what does it mean to live “on mission”.**

**Here is how our lead Pastor Randy Bezet describes it:**

**(As I read this slowly at each point, ask yourself - how can I grow in this area and if needed, who can help me with that?)**

- **By living on mission, we purpose our life and our work to know Him and make Him known. This is our goal as believers, whether we work in full-time ministry or the marketplace. Purpose your life, your priorities and activities around personally knowing Him more fully and making Him known to a broken world.**
- **Living on mission is to live and give generously - relationally, financially, with our time and talents. In every way! What does that look like in your own life? Do you steward your life - your time, talents and treasures - in a way that is generous?**
- **Additionally, as leaders at Bayside, living on mission is to understand that we are “owners of the House”. We are ambassadors of Christ to the community and world but we are “owners” of the ministry of the Gospel at Bayside. How can we make it better? How do we want our “guests” to be treated and loved? How can we improve their experience?**

**The gospel of Matthew records in one setting, the main body of the teachings of Jesus. It is found in Matthew chapters 5,6,7. Jesus teaches us what it means to live as a citizen of the kingdom of God, versus the kingdom of this world. His teaching was and is counter-cultural.**

**To live on mission is to display characteristics of a person pursuing the kingdom of God as Jesus describes it.**

**Characteristics such as being a servant, forgiving one another, being relationally generous, teachable, sacrificial, . . . .**

**One the next screen, We invite you to read through the sermon on the mount in Matthew 5, 6, and 7 and make your own list of what it means to live on mission.**
