Purpose: Liberation Academy's uniform policy promotes a positive school culture, minimizes distractions, and supports an equitable learning environment. Wearing the full uniform each day is a requirement for all **Solutionists**.

Required Uniform Components

Monday – Thursday: Standard Uniform

Solutionists are required to wear the full academic uniform:

- **Tops:** Long or short-sleeve **Liberation Academy polo shirts**.
- **Bottoms:** Black or navy blue uniform pants, skirts, shorts, or cargo styles. (Items must **not** be ripped or distressed).
- **Shoes:** Any closed-toe tennis shoes.

Friday: Spirit Days

Solutionists may opt for a more casual look while still representing our community:

- **Tops:** Any top from our **Swag Shop** (LA t-shirts, LA sweatshirts).
- **Bottoms:** Plain black or blue jeans. (Items must **not** be ripped or distressed).

Approved Daily Items:

- **Tops:** Liberation Academy polo shirts, LA t-shirts, LA sweatshirts.
- **Outerwear:** Liberation Academy crew necks, sweaters, or jackets.

Unauthorized Items

The following are **NOT PERMITTED** during the school day:

- Non-approved polos, pants, or sweatshirts.
 - **Hoodies** of any kind.
 - Outerwear without the Liberation Academy logo.
 - Hats, headscarves, or bandanas (unless for religious purposes).
 - Slides, sandals, or Crocs.
 - Distracting jewelry or accessories.

Consequences for Non-Compliance

Maintaining the uniform standard is a collective effort. The following steps will be taken if a Solutionist is out of uniform:

1. **First Infraction:** Verbal reminder to the student and parent notification via email.
 2. **Second Infraction:** Parent contact. The student will be required to borrow from the school's uniform closet. If a loaner is unavailable, an **invoice** will be sent to the family to cover the cost of a new uniform shirt.
 3. **Third Infraction:** Lunch detention and/or loss of extracurricular privileges (sports, clubs, or school events).
 4. **Ongoing Non-Compliance:** A mandatory family conference to establish a behavior contract.
