Carrick Wine Tasting Notes

Carrick Estate Range

Carrick Sauvignon Blanc 2023 – Aromas of gooseberry, lime, cinnamon and apple. The palate is soft, rich and rounded, with a lively, fresh acid line and notes reflecting the nose, alongside nettle and green apple.

Carrick Bannockburn Pinot Gris 2024 – An inviting nose of stewed apple and quince flows onto the palate. The rich fruit notes are complemented by sweet spice – cinnamon and star anise.

Carrick Bannockburn Pinot Blanc 2024 – Lovely balance on the palate, with fresh pineapple, yellow peach and baked green apple fruit notes, alongside a hint of pine needles. Moreish and engaging.

Carrick Bannockburn Chardonnay 2023 – Great balance between fruit, acid and oak. A long finish and notes of almond, white peach, salted caramel brittle and cinnamon. Whilst full and concentrated on the palate, it maintains a bright and refreshing palate feel.

Carrick Bannockburn Rosé 2024 – This dry Rosé is bright and fresh, with rose petal and cherry blossom notes on the nose. The palate is zippy and light, with tart cherry, strawberry and lemon rind. It's delightful and refreshing.

Carrick Unravelled Pinot Noir 2022 – Bright red fruits accent the core and add to the overall impression of lightness, fruitiness and balance. Quaffable and delicious – a true crowd pleaser.

Carrick Bannockburn Pinot Noir 2022 – Vibrant, elegant and balanced with notes of cherry, cranberry, redcurrant, thyme and tea leaf. The palate is long and complex, framed by fine tannin.



Discovery Range

Carrick Le Pét-Nat 2025: Peach-hued with a gentle fizz, crisp and revealing notes of strawberry, lemon and white nectarine. Bright refreshing acidity layered with subtle bready complexity and a saline minerality.

Carrick Pot de Fleur Pinot Noir 2025 – The palate has a velvety texture with soft grain tannin, good weight and depth, with notes of allspice, mint, dark chocolate, prune and cigars. Long and impressive.

Carrick Billet-Doux Pinot Noir 2024 – Full, moreish and powerful. Notes of forest floor, blackberry and black doris plum. Soft tannins and a long finish round out the palate.

Limited Release Range

Carrick EBM Chardonnay 2023 – Aromas of vanilla, almond, grapefruit and fennel, with a bright, driving line of acidity. Layers of baked stonefruit, white blossom, mandarin and lemon peel, lingering long on the finish.

Carrick Arthur's Pinot Noir 2022 – Floral with brambly fruit and a brooding depth to the palate. Whilst having a lightness to the palate, it is complex and contemplative. An incredibly elegant wine that will cellar well.

Carrick Magnetic Pinot Noir 2022 – It's rich and rounded with velvety tannins and ripe fruit forward character. Great balance with notes of star anise, nutmeg, toasted hazelnuts and baked cherries. A powerful wine that has great ageing potential.

Carrick Excelsior Pinot Noir 2021 – Fruit intensity, tannin and length are all found in ample portions, creating an overall feeling of balance and richness. Notes of toast, blackberry, chorizo and lavender flow through to the finish.

Carrick Josephine Riesling 2024 – That classic balance of zingy acidity and bright sherbetty sweetness. Pineapple, rock melon, lime and ginger marmalade notes. It finishes bright, fresh and clean. 53 g/L Residual Sugar.
