ORGANISATION

Ability to organise time and resources, attend lessons with all necessary materials, on time, plan ahead and complete tasks in a timely manner in order to adhere to deadlines.



LEARNING ENGAGEMENT

Commitment to maximising learning by actively engaging in set tasks; contributing positively to class discussions, asking appropriate questions to deepen understanding. Embracing and responding positively to feedback in order to strive for personal excellence; respecting others and behaving appropriately.



PERSISTENCE

Continuing to engage in learning even when the task is difficult; bouncing back after making a mistake by attempting challenging tasks more than once, in an effort to 'try and try again'. Strive for improvement and success and persist to extend learning and improve core skills to reach personal excellence.



COLLABORATION

Work cooperatively to effectively pursue continuation of projects by actively listening to others; contributing by sharing and communicating ideas and remaining on task to meet both group and individual objectives.



INNOVATION

Willingness to explore and generate new ideas, take appropriate risks, be resourceful to solve problems and continue to learn, in order to make improvements to a situation or problem.



CRITICAL THINKING

Purposefully engage by asking questions, evaluating, analysing outcomes and concepts to make judgements, being curious and explore to make meaningful connections.

- reflect on the success criteria and expectations of a task prior to submitting work
