Parents' guide to tuition fees, levies, concessions and payment arrangements.

Tuition fees

School fees are set and charged as an annual fee as listed in the table below. Several payment options are available to assist families in managing payments throughout the year. Year 12 fees are charged at the same annual level, with payment options available over four terms.

Kindergarten to Year 6 consumables: An additional amount is charged for consumable items: \$75 for Early Learning Years and \$125 for Years 2–6. This levy is in place of an extensive booklist required to be purchased by families.

Years 7–9*: Tuition fees include textbooks

Years 10–12: Textbooks are not included in tuition fees.

*For some secondary courses, a minor cost associated with textbooks will be applied to the fee account

Pre-Kindergarten

Pre-Kindergarten families are billed each term according to the number of sessions in that term. Each session is three hours and equates to half a day.

Sibling tuition fee discounts

Sibling discounts apply to tuition fees only and are available where two or more siblings attend the School at the same time under one fee account.

Family levies

Parents and Friends Association Levy (GST-free)	\$95	Per family

The Capital Levy assists in funding the School's building program and is used only for capital purposes. All parents are automatically members of the Parents and Friends Association. The P&F Levy supports equipment and items for the School, together with Association expenses.

The Capital Levy and Parents and Friends Association Levy are annual charges. There is no pro-rata adjustment for enrolment for part of the year.

Payment options for tuition fees

Families may select one of the following payment arrangements:

Making a payment

Payment may be made by BPAY®, EFTPOS, Direct Debit, the online portal, or Mastercard/Visa. Card payments can be arranged through the Accounts Office at fees@jsracs.wa.edu.au.

Families unable to pay by the due date must contact the Accounts Office to arrange an alternative payment plan. Legal action may be taken where fees remain overdue. Recovery costs, including commissions, fees and legal expenses, are payable by the parent or guardian.

Bank fees

Where a payment is unsuccessful because of insufficient funds, fees charged to the School by banks or other institutions will be recovered from the family at the current rate of \$5.00 per transaction.

Fee concessions

The School is mindful of families experiencing genuine financial need. Parents seeking a fee concession must complete a confidential application form and attend an interview with the Business Manager or delegate. Concessions are negotiated annually, are not ongoing, and are intended to assist enrolled families experiencing short-term financial hardship. Application forms are available from the Accounts Office.

Additional services and activities

Out of School Care

Out of School Care is available at the Mirrabooka Campus during school terms, Monday to Friday, from 7.00–8.30am and 3.30–6.00pm. Vacation Care is offered during school vacation periods from 7.00 am–6.00 pm. Fees are detailed in a separate brochure.

Music tuition

Students may learn a musical instrument during school time with private tutors. Music lesson fees are billed separately by the School at the end of each term in accordance with the guidelines in SEQTA. Please contact the School Office for further information. Family fees must be up to date for a student to continue music tuition.

School trips and tours

For a student to attend a tour, family fees must be paid in full or all regular payments must be current by the time the final tour payment is made. Where fees are not current, tour funds will be credited to the family fee account and the student's participation in the tour will be forfeited.

Secondary Assistance Scheme

Families holding a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card may be eligible for up to \$535 towards school expenses through the Government's Secondary Assistance Scheme. Up to \$300 is paid directly to the parent as a clothing allowance and \$235 is paid to the School towards school fees. Application forms and further information are available from Main Reception. Applications must be submitted before the end of Term One each year.

Important fee information

Please contact the Accounts Office as early as possible if your circumstances change or you anticipate difficulty meeting a payment date. Early contact allows the School to discuss appropriate arrangements with you.
