Description The house is double-fronted, of timber and possesses the simple hip-roof associated with age. Stuccoed-over chimneys and the slim joinery of the twin casement sash windows reinforces this view (Refer 26). A square head picket fence dates from early this century and a setting comprised of a clipped mirror plant and hedges provides the setting for a building which represents in form and actuality, the early cottages built in the government town of Tarraville of which only this house survives (Butler 1982:78).

Robert Webstell owned a “freehold” Tarraville during 1856, and was rated for a house in the town by 1863 (2). He also owned a house and land on Reeve’s Tarra Vale survey. By 1866 he was insolvent and appears have left the district.

By 1894, Mary Ann Shields owned it; to be replaced by John Shields in 1899. The Shields family occupied it for well into this century (4).
