The land formed part of a Government Reserve on a bend in the Tarra River, below Turnbull's bridge. During the early 1870's, eight lots, of varying size, were created, (1) west of Shaws Road, but little appears to have happened there until late in the century.

The above complex was built by Frank Gooch in 1896, after farming for a time in Devon. (2). The house has a high M-profile hipped roof with dichrome brick chimneys and a return verandah, decorated with scrolled timber brackets and valence. Cypress trees provide a backdrop to this relatively substantial house which was erected during the ascendancy of the dairying industry during 1890-1910 (Butler 1982:89).
