Expanding Access: Immigration Legal Advice

This spring, TLC launched limited immigration legal advice appointments through our Online Clinic in partnership with the University of Utah Refugee and Immigration Law

Clinic. We are grateful for partnerships that help expand access to legal services for vulnerable individuals and families throughout Utah.

Appointments are currently available on the second Tuesday of each month for eligible clients needing immigration-related legal guidance.

We are deeply grateful to everyone who supported TLC through the campaign.

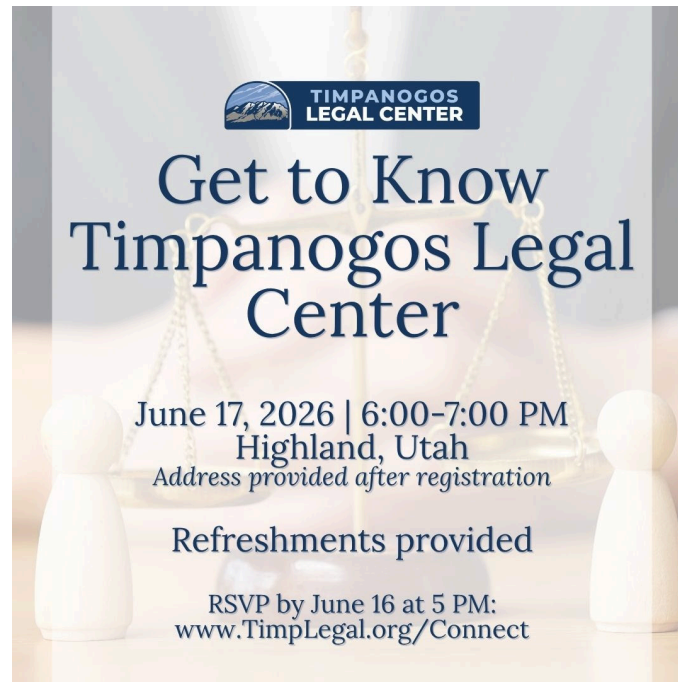
Community and Sponsorship Opportunities
