THE FIRST HALF: A RECAP

PRIMARY GOAL: 100% ENGAGED

We believe everyone at Harvester Christian Church has a role to play in this vision. That's why our goal is 100% participation across all campuses.

Status: In Progress

Next Step: Whether you're brand new to Harvester, new to church, or couldn't join us at the campaign launch, now is the time to jump in. It's never too late to make a difference.

SECONDARY GOAL: 200 UNLEASHED

Launching the O'Fallon Campus required 200 Harvester people to lead the mission at this new location.

Status: Completed

Next Step: By God's grace, we reached this goal and then some. More than 250 courageous Christ followers stepped up to make O'Fallon their home campus, not just to attend, but to serve, give, and invite. More than 600 people attended our Grand Opening on December 7, 2025!

TERTIARY GOAL: \$6-8 MILLION GIVEN

We are trusting God to provide \$6-8 million over 25 months, in addition to our regular giving, during this campaign. This is a bold step of faith!

These funds are focused on three priorities:

- Upgrading our Troy Campus to fit up to 400 on a weekend
- Purchasing and converting a bowling alley into a church facility for our O'Fallon Campus
- Covering the first two years of operating and ministry costs for O'Fallon as it gets established

Status: In Progress

Next Step: We've taken a huge step of faith to secure and renovate the facilities needed for Troy and O'Fallon. We must now complete what we started by fulfilling our commitments, so these spaces are fully funded and the ministry they serve can keep moving forward.

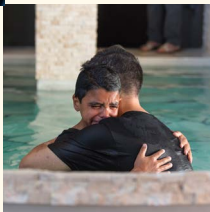

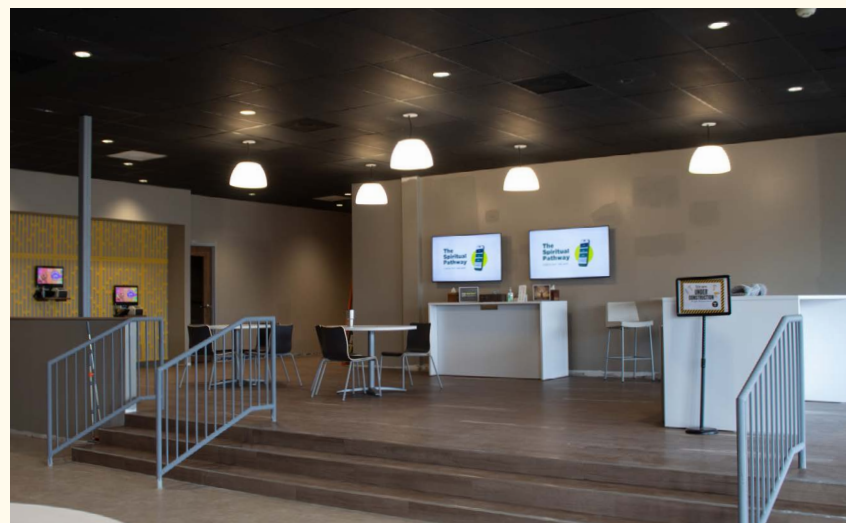

THE NEXT HALF: WHERE WE'RE GOING

By God's grace, the key facilities have been secured, and the work is underway. We are now entering the second half of the campaign with two clear priorities.

First, we will finish strong financially by fulfilling our commitments, ensuring the upfront costs of these projects are fully covered and we end this campaign with as little debt as possible. Less debt means more ministry.

Second, being "For the One" is not just about building buildings. It's about doing discipleship and ministry inside that space. "For the One" will help cover the first two years of ministry and operating costs at our O'Fallon Campus as it grows from infancy to strength.

We are still pressing toward our \$8 million goal to maximize our mission in Troy, O'Fallon, and across the St. Louis area.

WHAT IS YOUR ROLE?

Generosity is not a one-time event. It's a journey. As we reach the halfway point, it's worth taking an honest look at where you are and asking a few questions: Am I still giving in ways that challenge me? Am I still trusting God? Is God calling me to go deeper than I thought I could?

For the final year of "For the One," we're asking you to consider one of three commitments:



1. JOIN IN

If you've recently joined Harvester, "For the One" is for anyone who calls Harvester home. I want to invite you to join us for the final year of this campaign. Our hope is that everyone at Harvester participates in what God is already blessing by making a one-year commitment to generosity.



2. STAY FAITHFUL

Many of you at Harvester are rounding the corner on your commitments. You're heading into the second lap of this journey. The first year required real adjustments, but now you've found a rhythm that is making a difference in you and through you.

Your next step is simple: stay faithful and finish strong. That might mean catching up if you fell behind or keeping your rhythm through the final year.

3. STEP UP

Is it possible God is inviting you to take another step of faith? Maybe your finances have changed. Maybe your faith has grown. Maybe seeing the fruit has made you want to multiply it. For some, the next step is not just fulfilling your commitment but stepping up and increasing it for the final year so we can finish this campaign strong and expand what God is doing through Harvester.
