



## 2019 CARRICK BANNOCKBURN PINOT NOIR

Carrick Bannockburn Vineyard, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

The Carrick Bannockburn Pinot Noir is known for its structure and its ability to age well over a long period of time.

This wine is an integral part of what we do and a wine that we feel represents the strong connection we have with our land. The fruit comes from a parcel of vines which are entirely grown on their own roots and are the oldest vines we have on the property. Now 25 years old.

Winemaking: Hand-picked from the oldest vines on the estate, grown on their own roots. After a wild ferment, the wine is matured in oak for 11 months, 17% new. It is elegant with savoury notes, underpinned by a fine tannin structure.

Origin: Cairnmuir and Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, Central Otago

Hand-picked in: April 2019

Additions: Sulphur Dioxide (PMS), Yeast Hulls

Filtration and/or Fining: Coarse filtration, no fining.

Alcohol: 14.0% abv

Bottled: November 2020

Cases: 2088 x 6 bottle cases
