Viticulture and Wine Making

Carrick Riesling is grown on the Arthur Lot 8 Vineyard on the Cairnmuir Terraces at Bannockburn. The wine was fermented cool and clean in tank. One ferment was stopped before dryness to provide the residual sugar for the blend, with the main lot being left to go dry and rest on fine lees.

Tasting Notes

The Riesling from the Arthur vineyard is proving to be consistent in both quality and character. The aromas are of honeysuckle and citrus flowers with some subtle mineral notes. On the palate there are flavours of lemon meringue pie, limes and a core of green fruits and citrus. The fine natural acidity and mineral core is nicely balanced by the residual grape sugar to give both weight and a long clean finish.
