Viticulture and Wine Making

Carrick Riesling is a blend of grapes grown on the Carrick Lot 8 Vineyard in Bannockburn and fruit from the Bendigo sub-region. The wine was fermented cool and clean in tank. One ferment was stopped before dryness to provide the residual sugar for the blend, while the main lots were left to go dry and rest on fine lees.

Tasting Notes

The Riesling from Carrick is proving to be consistent in both quality and character. The 2007 has aromas of honeysuckle and citrus flowers with some subtle mineral notes. On the palate there are flavours of lemon meringue pie, limes and a core of green fruits and citrus. The fine natural acidity and mineral core is nicely balanced by the residual grape sugar to give both weight and a long clean finish.
