Viticulture and Wine Making All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the powerful floral aromatics and bright citrus acidity which are characteristic of Central Otago. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeast. The gentle handling of this wine means that it has been bottled without fining.

Tasting Notes An intense nose of red delicious apples, flinty minerality and pink grapefruit that will continue to open and develop over time. There is a core of lush pink grapefruit that runs the entire length of the palate which is matched by the finely balanced acidity giving this wine great harmony.
