Viticulture and Wine Making

All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the compelling floral aromatics which are characteristic of Central Otago Rieslings.

The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeasts.

Tasting Notes

The 2012 whites show fantastically rich aromatics. This Dry Riesling is no exception with grapefruit and jasmine characters which are pleasantly displayed in the glass.

A clean restrained acidity on entry, matched with low (12%) alcohol, shines through onto the palate. This wine exhibits citrus fruit characters, right through to the finish which is short, clean and free.

A balanced wine that will enhance a wide variety of seafood dishes.

Approachable now the 2012 dry Riesling will evolve smoothly for the next 5 - 7 years.
