Viticulture and Wine Making
All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the powerful floral aromatics and bright citrus acidity which are characteristic of Central Otago.
The grapes for this wine come solely from our Lot 8 block. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeast. The gentle handling of this wine means that it has been bottled without fining.

Tasting Notes
Lush, vibrant, opulent! Loads of citrus fruits, white nectarines and honey leap out of the glass giving this wine a very heady nose.
The sweet juicy entry is followed by a zesty lime acidity. This wine is all about poise, balance and elegance. Mouthwatering and fresh!
