The grapes for this wine come solely from our BioGro certified organic, Lot 8 block. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeast. | |
| Tasting Notes | A lively nose packed with grapefruit, honeysuckle and soft jasmine aromatics . The mouthwatering acidity is balanced with concentrated sweet fruit and the steely minerality gives the wine good focus. The harmony of this wine is formed in the four way balancing act of acidity, sweetness, phenolics, and alcohol content. No cultured yeasts nor fining agents were used to achieve this harmony. | |
