Viticulture and Wine Making	All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the powerful floral aromatics and bright citrus acidity which are characteristic of Central Otago. The grapes for this wine come solely from our BioGro certified organic, Lot 8 block. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeast.	
Tasting Notes	A lively bright nose packed with grapefruit, honeysuckle and soft jasmine aromatics . The acidity is balanced with concentrated sweet fruit and the steely minerality gives the wine excellent focus. The harmony of this wine is formed by the four way balancing act of; Acidity, Sweetness, Phenolics, and the low alcohol content. Enjoy as an aperitif, with cheese or simple poached fruit. This wine will age well into the future.	
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
