Viticulture and Wine Making	All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the powerful floral aromatics and bright citrus acidity which are characteristic of Central Otago. The grapes for this wine come solely from our BioGro certified organic, Lot 8 block. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented by wild yeasts.	
Tasting Notes	A lively bright nose packed with apricot, honeysuckle and a hint of wild fennel. A clean balanced wine with weight and texture. The fruit sweetness is focused by a steely minerality that leaves the mouth fresh. The low alcohol content makes this a perfect lunch time wine or an evening aperitif accompanied with cheese and simple poached fruit. This wine will age far into the future.
