Viticulture and Wine Making

Carrick Pinot Gris is grown at our Cairnmuir Road Vineyard.

We believe that the elements of a good Pinot Gris are distinctive flavours, with a richness and weight to the palate. This wine was whole bunch pressed and fermented using wild yeast to give complexity to the aromatics and also had regular lees stirring.

Tasting Notes

Delicate florals and aromas of pear and quince.

This Pinot gris is not driven by phenolic weight, but lead by a light sweetness on entry and guided by clean acidity. This is testament to the fruit quality and wine making, as no fining agents were used in the making of this wine. The lees stirring is truly identifiable in the rich textural element on the palate.
