Viticulture and Wine Making

Our Rosé is made using saignée and cold pressing techniques. Each parcel is individually fermented with wild yeast in old French oak barrels. After fermentation, the barrels are brought together in tank before bottling. A total of 6 different parcels provide the complexity and texture of this fine wine. The 2013 Rosé carries Organic Certification with BioGro NZ.

Tasting Notes

The gorgeous garnet colour evokes rich strawberry and red cherry aromas that flood from the glass. A textural weighty palate leads into a lush, "strawberries and cream" finish. An ideal lunch time wine, best served chilled and shared with friends.
