



## 2021 CARRICK UNRAVELLED PINOT NOIR

Carrick Bannockburn Vineyard, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

The Carrick Unravalled Pinot Noir is our early drinking offering for Pinot Noir lovers. It has all the care and attention of our other Pinots but is bottled earlier with less new oak.

20% whole-bunch, fermented with indigenous yeast, on skins between 18 – 29 days. Each vineyard parcel fermented separately, 7 different Pinot Noir clones. Matured in barrel for 7 months, no new oak, some second and third fill.

Origin: Towan, Cairnmuir Terraces, and Arthur's Vineyard,  
Carrick, Bannockburn, Central Otago  
Hand-picked in: March and April 2021  
Additions: SO<sub>2</sub>, Tartaric Acid, Yeast Hull Supplement  
Filtration and/or Fining: no fining, coarse filtration  
Residual Sugar: <2 g/L  
Alcohol: 13.0% abv  
TSO<sub>2</sub> at bottling: 46 mg/L  
Bottled: 21 December 2021  
Cases: 2007 x 6 bottle cases produced.
