



2022 CARRICK ARTHUR PINOT NOIR

Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

This single-block, single clone wine is named for the couple who established this Bannockburn vineyard, Sue and Bill Arthur. The northwest-facing aspect and the silty loam soils combine with the own-rooted old vines to carry a unique sense of place into this limited production wine.

Hand-picked and sorted in the vineyard, 100% 10/5 clone from 26 year old vines. De-stemmed to tank, fermented wild using a combination of pump-overs and punch-downs to manage the cap. On skins for 17 days, pressed, settled, and racked to barrels - for 10 months, 23% new.

Harvested: 29th March 2022

Additions: Tartaric Acid, Sulphur Dioxide, Yeast Hull Supplement

Filtration: No fining, no filtration

Total Acidity: 5.4 g/L

Residual Sugar: <1 g/L

Alcohol: 14.0% abv

TSO2 at bottling: 46 ppm

Bottled: 7th March 2023

Cases: 320 x 6 bottle cases produced.
