



## 2024 CARRICK JOSEPHINE RIESLING

Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

Josephine is the alternative name given by sailors to the Carrick Bend knot. Josephine, our reserve Riesling, is the first pick from the Arthur's Vineyard, a selection of the best bunches, hand-harvested and delivered to the winery. The sweetest wine of the range, it is a medium-sweet, mosel-esque style.

Hand-picked, whole-bunch pressed, then fermented using native yeast in tank. The fermentation is brought to a close when an appropriate balance of sugar and acid is found.

Harvested: 7th April 2024

Additions: Bentonite Clay (Fining), Potassium Metabisulphite (Preservative, anti-oxidant), Enzyme, Yeast Hull Supplement

Filtration and/or Fining: Sterile

Acidity: 8.7 g/L

Residual Sugar: 53 g/L

Alcohol: 9.00% abv

TSO2 at bottling: 90ppm

Bottled: 5th Sept 2023

Cases: 530 x 6 bottle cases produced.
