Summary: Maretti Italia is a vibrant range of wines from Pavia IGP, crafted to capture the spirit and generosity of Italian winemaking. Offering bold flavours and easy-drinking appeal, the range delivers exceptional value without compromising on quality. Maretti is all about approachable, everyday wines with a distinctly Italian soul.

Winemaking: Fruit was harvested at peak ripeness to capture Barbera's natural brightness and vibrancy. Following destemming and gentle crushing, fermentation was carried out in temperature-controlled stainless steel to preserve fresh aromatics, with careful extraction to maintain soft tannins and lively acidity. The wine was then matured in tank, with a small portion aged in older oak to round the palate without overshadowing the fruit. This approach results in a supple, fruit-forward Barbera with freshness, balance, and an easy-drinking style.

Vintage 2024: The 2024 vintage in IGP Puglia benefited from abundant sunshine and warm, stable conditions, allowing for optimal ripening and excellent fruit concentration. Cool nights helped preserve natural acidity, resulting in balanced, vibrant wines with rich flavour and freshness. Overall, the vintage delivered exceptional quality across the region—ideal for producing approachable, fruit-forward styles with real drinkability.

Tasting Note: Bright, juicy and effortlessly drinkable, Maretti Barbera opens list aromas of cherry and raspberry with hints of rose petals. The palate is medium bodied, fresh and extremely approachable. An everyday red well suited to your favourite pasta or pizza.
