**DAY
1 & 2**

Friday 12/11: Evening arrivals at KTM airport. Individual Welcome + Transfer to hotel in Boudha area.

Saturday 12/12: Visit of Bhaktapur Durbar Square with explanation of Nepal History and Distinction of spiritual influences (Hinduism and Buddhism). OPENING night Dinner with Nepal Team.

**DAY
3 & 4**

Sunday 12/13: Visit to Shechen Monastery's first DB4N project, after Breakfast. Visit the DB4N office and monkey temple and followed by lunch at a local restaurant. Dinner near the hotel.

Monday 12/14: Visit Kathmandu Durbar square, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then hop a board a luxury minibus for travel to the town of Pharping. Dinner and overnight accommodations at Champadevi Hillside Resort.

DAY 5

Tuesday 12/15: A day to enjoy Pharping... on foot. A walk through ancient temples, the visit to Guru Rinpoche's cave, and a picnic lunch on top of Hill prepared by our team! Dinner and overnight at Champadevi Hillside Resort.

DAY 6

Wednesday 12/16: After breakfast, departure in a luxury minibus for Gorkha Bazar, lunch on the way, and visit to Gorkha Palace, an icon of early Nepal. Overnight at Gorkha Garden Hotel.

**DAY
7 & 8**

Thursday 12/17: Immersion in the Rural municipality of Bhimsen Thapa, visit of schools and interactions with students, teachers, school leaders and reception by Mayor and administration in DB4N's very first Community Learning Environment Center, local overnight.

Friday 12/18: Breakfast and visit to another school, before departing for the trip back to Kathmandu, via Luxury minibus. Stay at the Hotel near Boudha.

DAY 9

Saturday 12/19: Breakfast reunion with DB4N team, celebration of our trip. Stay a while longer and get to discover more of Nepal.
