

# KT HEALTHCARE AUTISM ASSESSMENT

## 01. BEFORE YOUR ASSESSMENT

### Step 1: We check your forms

- You send us your questionnaires.
- A clinician looks at your answers.
- If there is enough information, we say yes to your referral.
- You go on our waiting list.

🕒 Time: **2 weeks after we get your forms.**

### Step 2: Waiting list

- You wait for your turn.
- When you reach the top, we contact you.
- We will book two appointments with you.

🕒 Time: **Waiting times change, check our website.**



## 02. ASSESSMENT

### One appointment (Talking about your life)

- You come with someone who knows you well (your informant).
- This appointment is **2–3 hours long.**
- A clinician asks questions about Your early life (age 4–5) and how you feel and act now
- After 30–60 minutes, the clinician may talk to your informant alone.

**Tip:** Bring a drink or snack to stay comfortable.

## 03. ASSESSMENT

### One appointment (Observation)

- Use a laptop or tablet, **NOT a phone**
- You come on your own.
- This appointment is **1–1.5 hours long.**
  - A clinician watches how you: talk, interact with others and think

## 04. DECISION MAKING

### Team meeting

- After the appointments, our team meets to decide if you meet the criteria for autism using the DSM 5.
- 🕒 Time: **3-4 weeks** after your second appointment.

## 04. OUTCOME

### Outcome call

- A lead clinician will call you with the result.
- The call may come from a 'no number'.
- If we can't reach you, we will email you to book a time.

🕒 Time: **3-4 weeks after your second appointment.**

### Your report

- You will get a written report. It includes: your diagnosis, a summary of your strengths and needs and general support ideas

🕒 Time: **4-5 weeks after your outcome call.**
