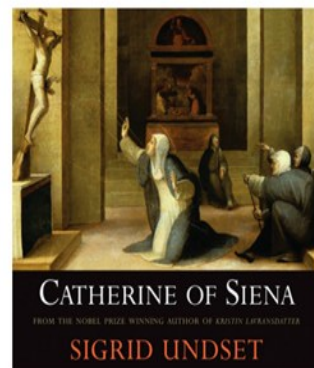

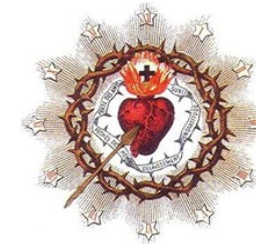

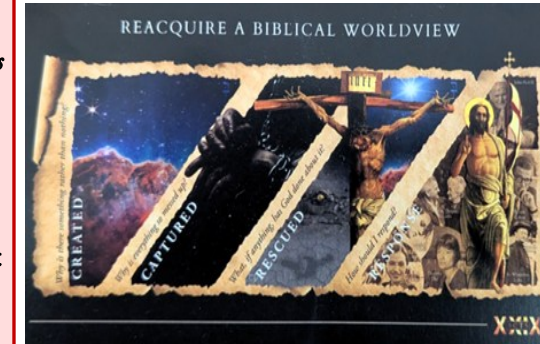

Esto Vir! is a vocation camp for young men entering their sophomore year of high school through young adulthood. The camp includes games, Mass, prayer, food, and fellowship.

There is an AED machine in the main body of the church. It is located in the back inside the ushers closet outside the cry room.

"And Peter said to them, 'Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ.....', ACTS 2:38
The word "repent" means to turn from sin - to change our thoughts, words and actions. Change that is permanent comes from within - a transformation or conversion of heart. This requires prayer, discipline and perseverance. Change is hard. The first step is recognizing that we are broken and that we need God's help. The good news - we are not alone in our journey. Ask Jesus daily for guidance and patiently listen for his response.

Do you shop at Central Market in DL? If you do have them put a "We Care" stamp on your receipt. Then bring that receipt to church and there is a wooden box in the main vestibule for you to put it into. Also do you purchase any "Our Family" products from them? Again if you do, cut the UPC code off and deposit that into that same wooden box. One of the Christian Mothers adds all those items up, submits them to Central Market and they in turn send us a percentage of money based on what was submitted. That money is used for Religious Education. Thank you for the support!
