At Pentecost, the whole entourage of Jesus' followers were gathered together in one place (Acts 1:14). The believers numbered 120 persons (Acts 1:15), a symbolic number for the full people. A strong driving wind fills the house, much as the mighty wind that swept over the chaotic waters at creation (Gen 1:2). The wind and fire symbols evocative of re-creation, not only on a personal level, emboldening frightened followers, but also signals a rebirth on a cosmic scale that will result from their mission to ignite Christ's love everywhere.
