Imagine a king who has everything...absolute power, infinite wealth, and an endless kingdom...yet chooses to spend his time alone in a dark room. It sounds miserable, right? Thankfully, that isn't our God.

Trinity Sunday is the cure for the misconception that God is a lonely, distant boss watching us from a cloud. Instead, the Trinity reveals something radical: at His very core, God is a family. Before the universe even existed, God was already a dynamic, bursting community of perfect love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

God didn't create us because He was lonely; He created us to invite us into the party.

When a person makes the Sign of the Cross, he isn't just brushing off his shirt or reciting a dry formula. He is wrapping himself in that divine family embrace. This week, let's live like we belong to that community. Reach out to someone who is isolated, and bring God's warmth out of the pews and into the world.

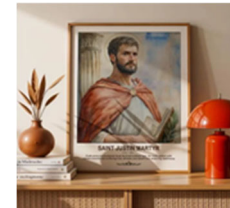
